The minutes from the September meeting were reviewed. Fred made a motion to approve the minutes, John seconded. Motion carried. There was no meeting in October.

The treasure's report was reviewed. Fred made a motion to approve, and Kevin seconded. Motion Carried.

Old Business:

Discussion was held on who would monitor the website for emails not that our site is up and running. Angie said she would do it if we would get her the information needed.

John reported that he had visited with Spring Prairie Colony as well as Shane Hendrix regarding contracting with someone other than the county for road maintenance. He will bring more information to the next meeting.

The ARPA grant of \$15,555.10 was rewarded to the township. A discussion was held on what to do with the money. It was decided to table it until the next meeting, and we would decide in December. The money can not be used for roads and bridges, pensions, or tax reductions or increases. There will be a reporting requirement that could mean monthly filing until the money is spent. We have until December 31,2024 to allocate the funds and until December 31,2026 to complete projects.

New Business:

The new meeting dates for 2022 were presented. All were okayed. Fred presented a motion to accept them with Kevin seconding.

The new census shows that the township has a population of 317 with 106 occupied households and 7 vacant.

Building permits were approved by the county for Kyle Camacho and Kirk Watt.
