It was decided to use some of the ARPA money to send \$1500 to Clay County Fair, buy new computers for the Treasurer and Clerk and then investigate donating some to the Fire Department. Fred made a motion and Kevin seconded.

The Quittschrieber building was not approved as no one came to the meeting. They were sent a notice from the county that they needed a building permit.

The August meeting will be on the 9th but will be held at Fuchs Sanitation building as the city will be having an ice cream social at the community center.

Ideas were once again discussed as to what to do with the ARPA funds but since we are to get more money, we decided to table it again until the next meeting and find out some more information on other avenues to help fund. John will be talking to the Clay County sheriff and Fred will get some more information from the fire department.

Road graveling was discussed and Fred will order the gravel that we discussed.

The 2021 Population and Household estimates show that the township has as of April 1, 2021 has a population of 319 with a household estimate of 107.

Justin from the Clay County Hwy dept will be at the July meeting so John will check and see if Frank wants to attend also.
