**Meeting Minutes:**

Members present were Fred Kuehl, John Winter, Ed Dorsett, Angie Kuehl, and Justin Thompson. Fred called the meeting to order at 7:09PM.

The minutes from March's meeting were reviewed. Fred made a motion to accept these minutes. Ed seconded the motion. The minutes were accepted and signed.

The Treasurer's Reports (Balance Sheet and Profit Loss YTD Comparison) were reviewed and signed by the present supervisors. Fred made a motion to accept the treasurer's reports. John seconded the motion. The motion passed

**Old Business:**

- Federal Land Trust on the property West of HWY 336.
  - The Tribe will be presenting to the county commissioner their plan on April 22 at the County Commissioners Meeting. The meeting will be held at 8:30am. The board members will try to attend the meeting to understand what the tribe is proposing.
  - John recommended that we shall reach out to Mahnomens County officials and other people impacted by the Shooting Star Casino. It is the boards understanding that the tribe stopped paying into the county after several years of paying. Justin will investigate further.
  - The conversation was tabled until next month, once we have a better understanding of what the tribe is proposing.
- Glyndon Fire Department 2025 Agreement
  - Glyndon Fire Department Township Agreement is due. The first half of the Fire Department agreement is due July 1st, 2025. The total agreement is for \$7,355. The board discussed the amount that the fire department is proposing to buy new equipment. Since there is no definitive cost to the township at this time the board tabled the discussion regarding addition cost for the fire department until June. Ed made a motion to sign the Fire Department agreement to commit to signing the \$7,355 Fire department agreement. John seconded the motion. Fred Signed the agreement. The motion passed. Justin will deliver the agreement to the City.

**New Business:**

- Township Maintenance agreement with the County.
  - Clay county sent the township a maintenance agreement. The County has asked for \$1,052.00 per mile. This is \$12 per mile more than last year. The contract would be valid from July 1st, 2025 through June 30th, 2026. The board members had a discussion regarding the quality of the maintenance and the convenience of the county providing the maintenance. It was agreed the County

did a fair job maintaining our township roads through the course of the last year. Ed made a motion to sign the Maintenance Agreement. John seconded the motion. Fred Signed the agreement. The motion passed. Justin attested to the signing and will turn it into Justin Sorum for his signature.

- The board members all initiated the 13.5 Glydon township millage certification.
- The Township received a letter from Bell Bank stating our CD renewal is up. The new maturity date is 3/15/2027. The new Annual Percentage Yield is 2.87 up from 2.85. No action taking.
