After the last meeting in which we discussed with Frank Gross the problems with the roads, Fred received a letter asking for a meeting so we could discuss our expectations of the service provided by the county and then they could tell us what they feel they should be providing. Kevin and Fred will set up a time and meet with them.

We received a letter from the State of Minnesota stating that the request to establish a new town in Spring Prairie township had been denied.

New Business:

Fred said that he had been contacted regarding the Annexation agreement between Dilworth and Glyndon. It has apparently expired, and they want to look at renewing it. The board decided we would wait and see if someone approaches us regarding it and then make a decision if we want to renew it.

Fred had also received a request from the Clay County fair requesting a donation. Fred made a motion to give them \$1500.00. Kevin seconded. Motion passed.

John brought forward a complaint from a resident regarding his neighbor's garbage and abandoned vehicles in his year. The neighbor had been talked to and said he would clean it up when he got a chance but that hasn't happened. The board told John that it

would need to go thru the County for that but that the township could possibly do something about the weeds.
